


2016 Owner's Manual

Thank You for Purchasing a Krivo Pickup for Upright Bass



To Install your new pickup, please carefully follow these instructions:



1. First, trim the supplied *Dual Lock*¹ fastener strip to match the shape of the end of your fingerboard, apply making sure to fully cover the bottom of the fingerboard, and let dry thoroughly for several hours.

2. Line up the magnetic pole-pieces with the strings and firmly press the pickup to the bottom of the fingerboard. The fastener should "snap" securely into place. The poles should be close to the strings but not so close as to touch the strings or to interfere when playing in higher positions. At no point should the pickup or poles hit—the strings; an unpleasant noise may result! More distance from the strings yields a more natural "acoustic" tone—but too far will have insufficient output.

3. Remove the G string from your bass and thread it through the included cable clip (as in the photos left and right). When tightened the string will then hold the clip and 1/4" inch audio jack in place:



¹ Please note: The included 3M "Dual Lock" fastener is *not* velcro—it purposely has the same texture on *both* sides and is much stronger than traditional "hook and loop" Velcro).

Re attach the G string and tighten it to pitch with the clip now holding the jack securely into place as in the photo at right:

The jack slips easily in and out of the clip when you need to remove the pickup from your bass.

4) Finally, plug in your amplifier's cord into the jack, and you are ready to make music.

You may finely adjust the pickup's pole piece height for perfect string-to-string balance: use the included Hex Wrench to *loosen* a pole to bring it closer to string, which will make that particular

string *louder*. Conversely, you may *tighten* a pole to *decrease* volume of a particular string.

Please test out your pickup thoroughly upon receipt—all sales are final 15 days after you receive your pickup.
